

District 7 Chapter Project Grant



Purpose:

The objective of this grant is to recognize and assist in funding an exceptional project or activity proposed and performed by a chapter(s) in District 7. The intent is for this grant to assist a chapter(s) in the execution of an outstanding project or activity that will improve both the chapter's & Tau Beta Pi's image on campus and / or in the community or improving a chapter's membership.

Description:

The District 7 Chapter Project Grant provides a minimum of \$250 to be used by the acknowledged chapter(s) to fund a project or activity that is deemed by the District Directors of District 7 as being exemplary in the field of chapter improvement. A representative from the identified chapter(s) will be recognized by a Tau Beta Pi National Official at the annual District Conference for District 7 in front of the attending student body. The rewarded chapter(s) must also prepare a brief presentation on the details of the project including purpose, execution, budget and assessment.

Designation of the District 7 Chapter Project Grant shall be based on, but not limited to, the criteria listed below at the discretion of the District 7 Directors and follow the prescribed application procedure.

Criteria:

- Project must have a focus on improving a chapter's image on campus and / or in the community or a focus on improving a chapter's membership
- Project should aspire to approximately meet or exceed the minimum \$250 monetary grant

Procedure:

- Complete the District 7 Chapter Project Grant application form and submit to District 7 Directors by November 9th
 - Designate person(s) as point of contact for submitted project that will be available to clarify any questions during District Director's review process
- Along with or contained within the application form submit:
 - Project description and purpose
 - Anticipated itemized budget
 - Clear project timeline / execution plan with required team members and assigned tasks
 - An assessment plan to evaluate a projects success
- The project(s) of the rewarded chapter(s) will be announced by November 30th
- Arrangements of receipt of funds shall be coordinated between project point of contact and District 7 Directors
